Please note that the FCA Board of Directors has decided that digital art will no longer be accepted in FCA shows. So starting in 2014, the Victoria Chapter shows will no longer consider digital art for our exhibitions.

There is clarification of the framing guidelines as follows: UNFRAMED canvasses or wood panels must have all sides painted and the staples must be on the back of the stretcher bars *for canvas*. Canvas paintings *and wood panels* that are less than 1.5 inches deep must be framed.
